Key numbers

- About 400 000 adults in Norway lack sufficient skills in reading, writing and numeracy to master the challenges of today's working and social life.
- Poor reading skills is the third most important cause to exclusion from the work life
- One in five workers do not master the current technology
- Those who do not use computers daily in their job, are most vulnerable
- 20 percent of the population say they would rather not take on political office that involves use of numbers and calculations.

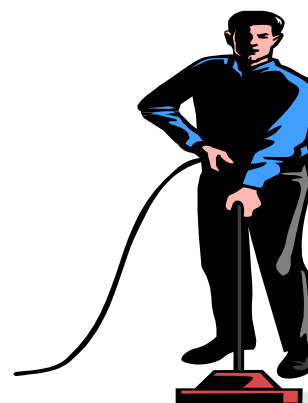
The Framework

The Framework for Basic Skills for Adults establishes national standards for reading and writing, mathematics, ICT skills and oral communication.



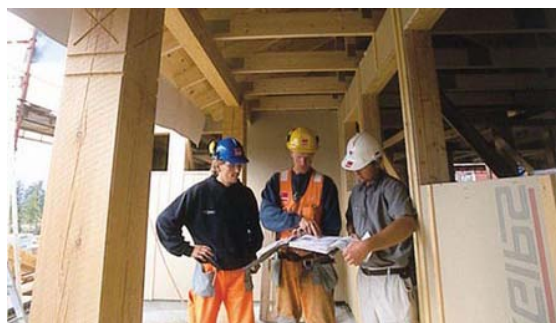
Basic skills are required
